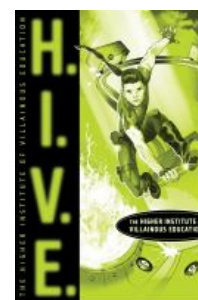

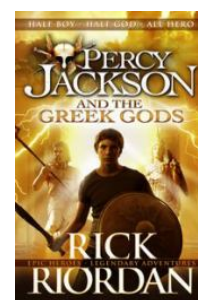

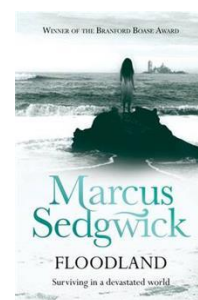


## Floodland

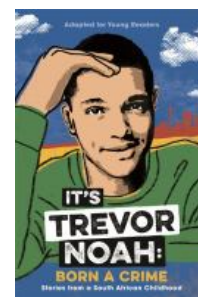


## It's Trevor Noah: born a crime

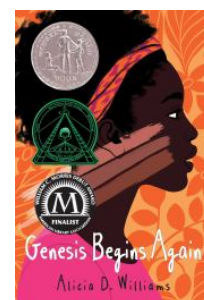
## Genesis begins again
